General Information

The Board of Directors (BOD) meets on the 4th Tuesday of each month at 6:30 PM. Meetings will remain virtual until further notice.

Garbage and recycling pickup is on Thursday. Bins should be taken back in by Thursday night. Secure garbage from wind and animals. See Anne Arundel County website for holiday and snow emergency schedule changes.

Dogs AND cats must be leashed when outside and **you must clean up after your pets.**

Tot Lot closed from dusk to dawn. Anyone there during those hours can be charged with trespassing. Residents are urged to call the police if they see/hear anything in the Tot Lot after dark.

Exterior changes, including landscaping, must be approved in advance *via an Architectural Change Application (ACA)*.

ACA's must first be submitted to Victory Mangement (VMI) Property Manager. Once they are logged in at VMI, they are forwarded to the Board for review and action. You will receive official notice of approval or denial.

The lease addendum will certify that copies of the *Rules & Regulations and By-Laws* have been provided to the tenant and that they hold the required HO4 tenant policy with the appropriate requirements.
